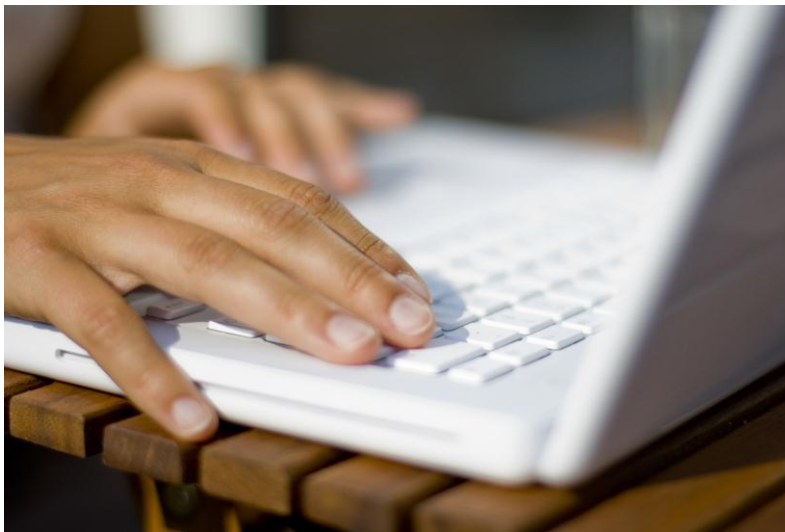


Knowledge Is Power
