

Obligation to Self-isolate of Positively Tested Persons, Members of the Same Household, and Close Contacts

Positively tested person (primary case)	Self-isolation as soon as the person knows of the positive test 10 days quarantine as of the day of the first positive test		
	The quarantine period may be ended on day 7 by a negative rapid test in case of an absence of symptoms for at least 48 hours		
Person belonging to the same household	No obligation to isolate or undergo testing	10 days of isolation as of the date of the positive test of the primary case (isolation period as of the day of the first positive test of the primary case)	The quarantine period may be ended on day 7 by a negative rapid test
Close contact	No obligation to isolate or undergo testing	10 days of quarantine after the last contact to the primary case	The quarantine period may be ended on day 7 by a negative rapid test
